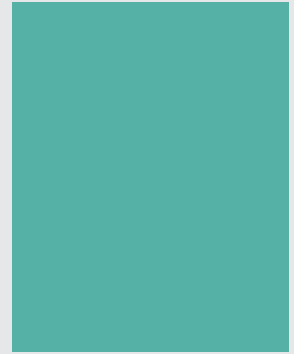
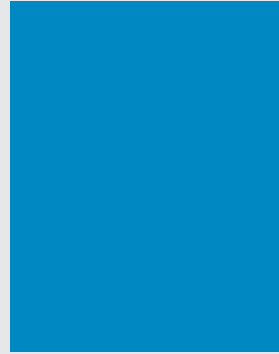


Sun City Beaufort County, South Carolina



Challenge

Securitas USA is the leading provider of contract security services for the private plantation communities on Hilton Head Island and beyond, offering a wide range of residential services.

At Del Webb's Sun City development in Beaufort County, SC, a gated community of more than 7,500 rooftops and over 15,000 residents. Securitas USA uses the visitor management system to help control access and document more than 100 contractors and as many as 300 guests who arrive at the main gate each day. Securitas USA security officers also perform many law enforcement duties as they patrol the 100 miles of private roads within the community.

Solutions

"Our officers serving private communities in this area have the same arrest authority as police do," explains Don Feldkamp, Securitas USA branch manager. "All 38 officers receive South Carolina Law Enforcement Division training and are Red Cross certified in CPR, first aid and AED."

Securitas officers at Sun City patrol roads, issue in-house traffic citations, and serve as first responders in the event of emergencies. In the case of serious traffic accidents, injuries, or medical conditions, the South Carolina Highway Patrol, Beaufort County Sheriffs' Department and/or EMTs are summoned, as appropriate. But most incidents are handled by Securitas USA's experienced officers.

Securitas USA's site manager at Sun City, is Thomas Yurkin, a retired Captain from the Bergenfield, NJ Police Department and Assistant Site Manager Michael Sisino, a retired Lieutenant with the Vermont State Police and Franklin County Sheriff's Department. Other Securitas USA officers at Sun City include John Atkinson, a retired Lieutenant from Woodbury City, NJ Police Department, Jim Graham, a retired Trooper with the Pennsylvania State Police, Larry Ruocco, a retired Sergeant with the Waterford, NJ Police Department and Robert Crewdson, an FBI agent with 30 years of service.
