Challenge:

Manheim, a Cox Automotive brand, needs to protect a vast array of cars housed outdoors at its 78 wholesale auto auction sites in the U.S. The industry pioneer looked to Securitas for assistance with improving its security without adding significant labor costs.

Solution:

Securitas developed a customized Integrated Guarding plan with Electronic Security as well as On-site and Remote Guarding. High-definition outdoor IP cameras with a Video Management System and audio recording capabilities now span Manheim's facilities. These cameras send alerts for Remote Guarding officers, who then investigate and respond as required. The ability to integrate video analytics with guarding, as well as physical perimeter barriers provide a valuable solution for our client.

Result:

This Securitas solution resulted in the recent apprehension of a trespasser attempting to drive a stolen vehicle off a lot at Manheim Southern California. After being notified by an analytic alert, Remote Guarding officers investigated the event and quickly engaged On-site Guarding and local police. The police responded swiftly, and the suspect was apprehended before even leaving the lot. This solution maintained On-site Guarding services where appropriate, reduced theft, and improved tracking of both customers and visitors.
