



Recharging Security for an Electronics Manufacturer

A broad-line manufacturer of electronic components in the Northeast has been a Securitas client for over a decade.

Challenge:

The client's goals were to:

- Increase security efficiencies including expanding Electronic Security infrastructure.
- Maintain or reduce annual spend.

Solution:

A local Securitas branch manager and the client's security director made an informed decision based on a Securitas Risk Assessment focusing on the adoption of Remote Guarding coverage and a reduction in On-site Guarding. The new services included:

- Remote Guarding patrols at predetermined intervals, proactively looking for potential threats.
- Integration with the client's 35 existing cameras and expanded video storage.
- 360-degree fisheye cameras added to storage rooms.
- Wireless panic buttons (which alert Remote Guarding officers) carried by employees who work alone during off-hours.
- On-site Guarding continuing during high-activity hours.

Result:

- Remote Guarding services have consistently alerted the client to activity outside of normal parameters.
- The Remote Guarding team has continued to perform quality checks, allowing for enhancements such as:
 - Expanding cameras' field of view.
 - Increasing system uptime.
- The client reduced annual spend by nearly 40%.
